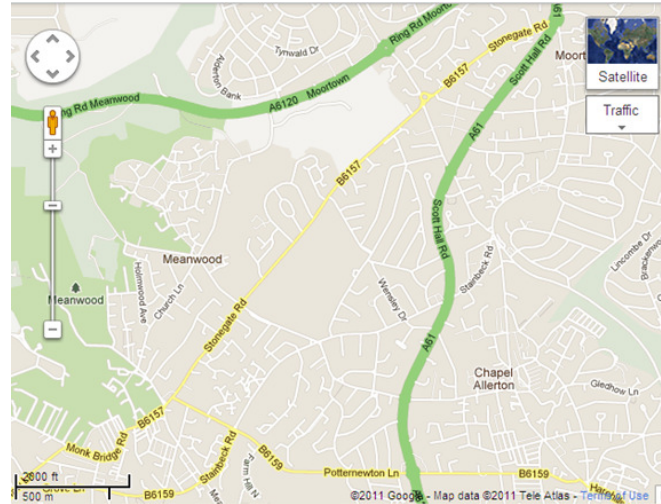

What is BTEC Level 3 Diploma/ Extended Diploma: Performing Arts or Sport?

•This is a two year full-time course providing a specialist, work-related programme of study. It covers the key knowledge and practical skills required for those who have an interest in sport, and physical activity, or performing arts. It will give you the opportunity to develop your knowledge and investigate a wide range of aspects; from the scientific to the sociological; from the psychological to the nutritional. The course consists of either 12 units (Diploma) or 18 units (Extended Diploma) over two years.

Is this suitable for me?

Whether you are considering going to University, working in the industry as an administrator, developing your own skills or teaching others this is an appropriate course for you. A significant part of the course is dedicated to developing your skills as a trainer, manager and organiser, with excellent opportunities to work with your peers, primary school pupils, younger pupils within school and some external groups.

How will I be assessed?

This is a coursework only qualification. Assignments are written and presented in a variety of way including: presentations, demonstrations, video evidence and self reflection.

Each unit will be graded Pass, Merit or Distinction. Your overall grades will be determined by how well you have achieved across all units. You will be awarded two or three grades on completion of the course.

How will I learn?

You will be taught by specialist teachers through both practical and theoretical approaches. You will study a number of core units; plus additional specialist units. These cover a wide range of aspects from nutrition, prevention of injuries, risk assessment, work experience, organising events and personal performance.

The Extended Project & Additional AS levels

The Extended Project is a structured piece of work designed to teach students how to be an independent learner, that will stand them in good stead for their level 3 course and HE (worth 30 UCAS points). All students will undertake this qualification.

Additional AS levels are offered within school and in collaboration with other local schools. (each AS level is worth 20-60 UCAS points). Options may include: General Studies, History, Sociology, English, Further Maths;

Guiseley AFC Football Academy

The Football Academy scheme is operated through the Football Conference League and offers students aged 16–19 years old the opportunity to train and play football alongside studying for a nationally recognised qualification. In this case it is a Level 3 BTEC award in Sport.

In addition to their studies the Football Academy students but will also undertake 6–8 hours of football & fitness training; and participate in league and cup games as Guiseley AFC Football Academy.
